

2009 Professional Development Grants – January: Funding Recipients

Dunedin ACE Network:

Facilitate four training and development workshops which look at Keeping Up with Technology, Dispute and Conflict Resolution, Te Reo and Energisers and Motivators. The workshops aim to encourage, strengthen and support lifelong learning, social cohesion of ACE Network Members, improving capability of the providers and collaborating partnership with Māori and Pacific Island communities.

Auckland ACE Network.

Facilitate a mini-conference to increase ICT capability and awareness in the ACE sector. The conference workshops will include topics such as Google tools, social networking and creating and managing your own websites.

Eastern Bays (Auckland) Network

Training tutors of the learning activities undertaken by community providers in the Eastern Bays network. Professional Development training will give these tutors the necessary skills and confidence to improve delivery of the learning activities.

Adult Literacy Aotearoa (Kapiti) Inc

Facilitate 6 Professional Development sessions aimed at up skilling tutors and providing them with the latest literacy and numeracy development which help them in tutoring their students.

Western BOP ACE Network

Convene, organise and facilitate the second Annual PD-Big Day Out (PD BDO) for ACE providers in Western Bay of Plenty. The BDO aims to strengthen the network and broaden participation and collaboration between providers.

Mid Canterbury ACE Network

Provide workshop training which will give an overview of the processes involved that a group needs to work through in order to produce a strategic plan which can be owned by its members as well as a set of templates to use later.

Volunteer Western BOP

To provide advice, training and information to organisations, groups and individuals in all aspects of volunteering in Western Bay of Plenty.

FWEA Aotearoa NZ

Facilitate Bi-annual Professional Development workshops and training for FWEA staff and governance.

Te Kupenga O Manukau ACE Network

Facilitate a Mini-Conference in May 2009 to address ACE Professional Development priorities.

Auckland Workers Educational Association

To facilitate Professional Development funding to support three PD training activities in 2009: Delivery of a stream of workshops for Treaty educators, a workshop for ACE providers about application of Treaty in ACE and a one day mini-conference of multiple workshops about appropriate and effective practices in relation to cultural diversity.

Wellington & Hutt & Kapiti & Porirua Combined ACE Network

To provide a series of Professional Development opportunities for ACE Practitioners in the ACE Network.

REAP Marlborough

Facilitate ten (10) two hour 'Train the Trainer' sessions, one topic per month. Where 8 Pacific Island advocates will be trained in areas of need identified by their communities such as health, workers rights, legal issues, drugs and alcohol, literacy, after school programme, food and nutrition, education from ECE to Tertiary and Māori culture. This will enable advocates to go out in to their communities and teach their people what they have learnt in ways that are suitable to the communities.

Community Learning Association Through Schools

To plan deliver and evaluate four (4) new Professional Development Modules and Three(3) PD Resource Development Workshops.
